

# AMARILLO ISD DICK BIVINS STADIUM INFORMATION

## 1. STADIUM ADDRESS

- 3101 SE 10th or located at the corner of SE 10<sup>th</sup> & S Marrs Street
- Use the Grand Street Exit

## 2. FAN SEATING/TICKET BOOTHS

- Ticket Booths are located on the South end of the Stadium and on the North end of the stadium. Booths will open 1 ½ hours prior to the start of the game.
- There are 4 entry gates. 2 on the North Side and 2 on the South Side.
- Home fans will enter on the Northwest gates and on the Southwest gates.
- Visiting fans will enter on the Northeast gates and on the Southeast gates.

## 3. PARKING

- Football teams/Trainers/Band buses/vehicles will unload on the North end at the Tunnel. Bus drivers will be instructed by our Athletic Crew as to where to park.
- Band equipment truck must park in the designated area given by our Athletic Crew and must be parked before unloading equipment.
- Boosters carrying blow up helmets, mascots, flags, etc may take their truck and trailer down the tunnel to unload, but they **must have a wristband/pass to enter through the tunnel.** Please contact Kathy Lovett @ 806-326-1102 for wristbands. Once all equipment has been unloaded the truck and trailer must be parked outside in the parking lot.

## 4. STADIUM RULES

- No outside food or drink will be allowed in the stadium.
- No coolers allowed in the stadium
- Fans will not be allowed to cross from one side to the other.
- Fans will not be allowed to enter onto the playing field.
- No Propane tanks with bb's.
- No use of Tobacco products in the stadium.
- Students leaving the stadium will not be allowed back in unless they purchase another ticket.

## 5. FIELD AREA

- Food, drinks (other than water or what the Trainers provide), gum, sunflower seeds and tobacco are prohibited at all times around or on the field area.
- Wristband passes must be worn in order to gain access to the sideline areas (except coaches). No wristband no access and you will be asked to leave.
- Family and friends are not allowed onto the playing field after the game.
- All student filmers, student photographers must have either a team shirt on or a badge/wristband identifying who they are and what their purpose is for being on the sidelines/field.
- Cheerleaders that are in game uniforms do not need a pass, but any sponsors must have a school badge or wristband to gain access through the tunnel and for the sidelines.
- Band sponsors must have a wristband or the schools badge to gain access through the tunnel and for the sidelines.
