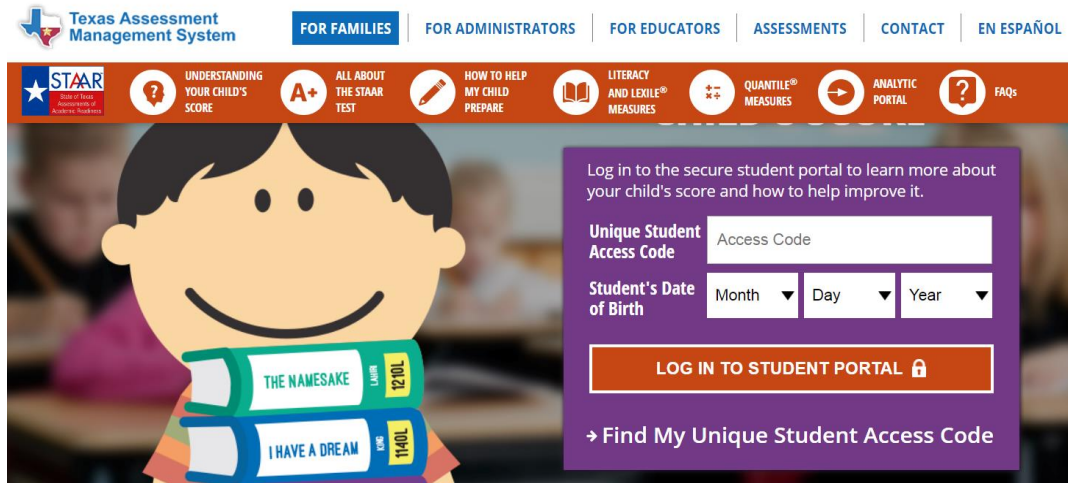


# Accessing the Student Portal for Test Results

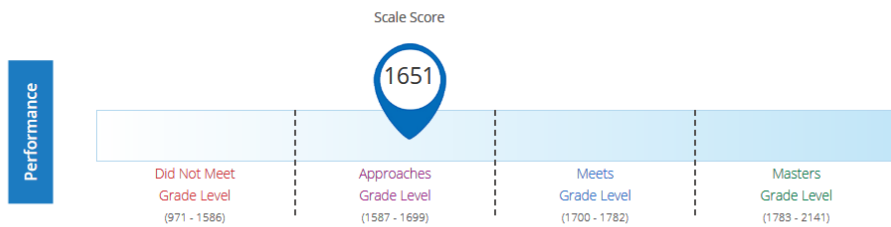
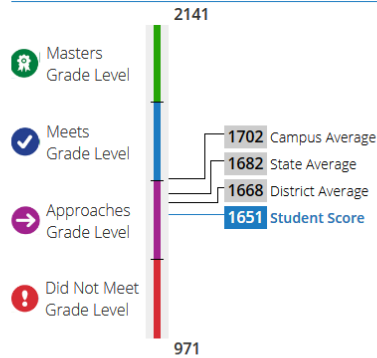
