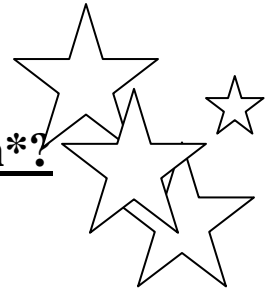


When is a Sound Error a Concern*?
